Promoter's Conditions

1. All events shall be competed for annually under Swim England Laws and Regulations and Swim England Technical Rules of Racing at Newton Abbot Leisure Centre (or other suitable venue), on dates approved by the Swimming Club Committee.
2. All swimmers shall have their longest unbroken membership with Newton Abbot Swimming Club (NASWPC) for at least 60 days before the first day of the competition.
3. All swimmers will have their Swim England Membership paid by NASWPC and not have another club ranked on their Swim England Membership.
4. No members shall be eligible to compete in any event or receive any prizes unless all their liabilities to NASWPC including annual membership subscriptions and training fees are paid up to date.
5. In the interests of the sport, in cases of extenuating circumstances, the committee shall decide if the swimmer is eligible to compete. That decision shall be final.
6. In each event, medals shall be presented to the swimmers finishing first, second or third in each age group. (See also **10.**)
7. Trophies, where applicable, will be presented to the winners at a Presentation ceremony to be held after the completion of the competition on a date agreed by the committee, usually in the following January. Winners of all club trophies shall enter into a bond for their safe custody and return them when requested to the Trophy Steward in good condition and in good time for the Presentation ceremony.
8. Championship events shall be arranged appropriately over a series of dates in September, October and November and December as agreed by the committee.
9. All championship events shall be swum in seeded heats where possible. Swimmers with no entry time will be placed in the early heats as appropriate to their ability or may be allocated an estimated entry time in order to facilitate appropriate seeding.
10. All championship events shall be swum as Heat Declared Winners (HDW).
11. Swimmers will be required to swim in one of two groups, Female or Open/Male swimmers. The Female category is for birth sex females in accordance with Swim England's Transgender and Non-Binary competition policy for swimming. By entering the 'Female' category, a swimmer confirms that their birth sex is female.
12. Competition Age Groups shall be as follows: **9yrs and under, 10yrs, 11yrs, 12-13yrs, 14-15yrs and 16yrs&over**. Ages shall be as at 31st December in the year of competition.
13. Entries shall be made to the Competition Secretary by a date approximately 7 days before the first day of the competition, or as agreed by the committee and published. **No late entries will be accepted.**
14. Entry is £1 per race up to a maximum cost of £10 to cover all events but swimmers are advised to check with their coaches/teachers with regard to their ability to complete the events entered satisfactorily.
15. Following the completion of all championship events, four Medley "Skins" events shall be held as follows: Junior Skins - female and male/open 13&U, and Senior Skins - female and male/open 14&over. Swimmers for these events will be the top 6 female swimmers and 6 male/open swimmers in each age group from the Club Championship 200m Individual Medley. The Skins events will be held on a date agreed by the committee, 14 days' notice will be given to swimmers that have qualified. ***The Skins events are not part of the Championships and times will not be submitted to SWIM ENGLAND Rankings.***
16. All Officials are invited to claim expenses for reasonable and necessary outlay. Mileage will be checked, and verification may be requested before payment is made. Payment for mileage will be made at £0.45/mile and will normally be between home address and the venue.

2023 Newton Abbot Club Championships

- In line with Promoter's Condition 1. above, the Meet will be held under Swim England Laws and Regulations and Swim England Technical Rules of Racing, times achieved can be used for entry into County Competitions (subject to County approval). The Meet dates and sessions shall be as follows:
 1. Friday 24th November warm up 19:00
 2. Tuesday 28th November warm up 19:00
 3. Saturday 2nd December warm up 14:00
 4. Sunday 3rd December warm up 14:00
 5. Tuesday 5th December warm up 19:00
- Entries must be made to through the Active Swim Portal by midnight on Friday 17th November. No late entries will be accepted. The entry form is on Page 5 of this Meet Pack.
- All events will be will be swum as mixed events, but awards presented separately as female and male/open awards within the relevant age groups.
- For safety and security reasons, the wearing of jewellery is not permitted while in the water during warm-ups or competition. This includes watches, necklaces, chains, bangles, wrist bands, earrings (except studs), and rings (except wedding bands).
- Neither Newton Abbot Swimming & Water Polo Club nor Newton Abbot Leisure Centre accept any liability for any loss or damage to personal belongings.
- Entries and results for this Meet will be held on computer. As required by the Data Protection Act 2018, submission of entries implies consent to the holding of personal information on computer. These details may be made public before, during or after the Meet.
- As there is no longer a requirement for photographic devices to be registered before a swimming gala, Newton Abbot Swimming Club will adhere to the Swim England guidelines as set out in Wavepower 2016-19: Child Safeguarding Policies and Procedures for Clubs.
